The Board of CCDNSW met last week to consider 11 expressions of interest in the distribution of CCDNSW's assets, equipment and reserves. The process was in accordance with CCDNSW's constitution and its winding up requirements.

After considerable deliberation it was decided to donate equipment and half of the surplus to OCTAPOD and the other half surplus to Auburn Cultural Development Network (ACDN).

The Chair of CCDNSW, Lex Marinos: "The board acknowledges the merit of all the applicant organisations and felt its legacy would reside comfortably with them all, but finally the decision was made in favour of two organisations. OCTAPOD is a vibrant regional organisation, and ACDN is based in Western Sydney where it has a rich history of outstanding CCD achievements. This result seems a fitting representation of CCDNSW's work over the past 25 years. We were delighted that the expected surplus, though modest, looks sufficient to make a meaningful contribution to both organisations. Thanks to all the organisations that expressed interest in the assets and we wish them every success in their future programs."
